- A certificate in Public Health from Gretsa University or any other institution recognised by Gretsa University Senate and PHOTC

Bridging Courses: A holder of KCSE certificate or equivalent with a minimum of C (Plain) but lacking the Mandatory cluster subjects may be required to undertake a bridging course in the respective courses offered at Gretsa University or any other university to qualify for entry.

PROGRAMME DURATION

The duration of the programme will be 8 semesters (7 semesters' course work and one semester for attachment).
